

The next page asks about your facilities and the pitches that you use. Next we require the name and postcode of your most frequently used pitch. In order to help us expand our knowledge of pitches in England you can also provide the surface type, the hourly cost and frequency of use, as well as what you use the pitch for. Additionally if you have any relevant comments to add around the pitch such as accessibility issues or the condition of the pitch please provide these in the comments box at the bottom of the page. 
