FEMALE VICE-PRESIDENT OF ENGLAND HOCKEY

There is a requirement for a Female Vice-President to be elected to England Hockey at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting in March 2021.

The primary role of the Vice-President is to support the President in his/her duties and in doing so strengthen the reputation and profile of England Hockey both domestically and internationally. The role should be seen as a stepping-stone to the potential election as President.

The Vice-President's duties will include;

- Attendance at England Hockey domestic tournament finals, both indoor and outdoor, with a view to presenting trophies and medals to successful teams and players. Tournament venues to be located throughout England at various times of the year.
- Attendance at various invites, both domestically and internationally, for other tournaments, matches and functions. Potentially hosting and speaking as required.
- Form part of working groups for specific projects as deemed appropriate from time to time

The appointment will be for an initial term of three years and will be particularly interesting as it will coincide with the staging of the Commonwealth Games in Birmingham in 2022, where both the men's and women's England squads will be competing for podium places.

Summary

The Vice-President will fulfil a vital representative role for England Hockey and the wider game. The successful candidate should have significant inter-personal skills, a reasonable amount of free time, particularly at weekends, and have a passion for the sport and all its participants.
