## VICE-PRESIDENT OF ENGLAND HOCKEY

Two Vice Presidents are to be appointed, one of each gender.
The primary purpose of the Vice President is to support the President in his/her duties and thus to prepare themselves as potential candidates to succeed the President.

The Vice Presidents may be required to stand in for the President in any of the functions detailed in the role description of the President.

Vice Presidents will in particular:

- Represent England Hockey at its own tournaments, matches and other functions
- Represent England Hockey in response to invitations, internationally and domestically at tournaments, matches and other functions
- Form part of working groups for specific projects as deemed appropriate from time to time
- Embrace the role so as to strengthen hockey's reputation and profile, domestically and internationally

The Vice Presidents will be invited to attend meetings of the Regional Consultative Committee.

The Vice Presidents fulfil vital representative roles for the sport. The positions require dedication and a passion for the sport.

## Time Commitment

Vice Presidential duties require about 20 days per annum

## Expenses

The position is an honorary one, but reasonable expenses, in line with England Hockey's expense policy will be paid.
