LEAVES & TREE DEBRIS

The inevitable accumulation of leaves, twigs and other debris on the pitch is a daily occurrence at this time of year.

If not removed this material can start to mulch down and contaminate the pitch, resulting in slippery, none draining areas.

The longer this material is allowed to build up the more arduous the task to remove so ideally daily or maximum weekly removal with blower, brush and rake should help to manage the problem

Machinery/Equipment needed:

Blower, leaf collector, dragmat and brush

Frequency of operation:

Ideally daily (particularly in autumn) or minimum weekly.

Purpose:

To ensure the surface is kept clean and safe and to reduce potential contamination.

Tip:

Cut back any overhanging trees/bushes.
